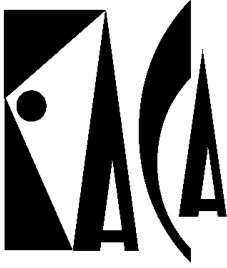

OVERVIEW & ELIGIBILITY

The two exhibitions are open to regular and student members who renew (or begin) their KACA membership for 2010-11 (the membership period from the 2010 conference to the 2011 conference). Payment of 2010-11 membership dues need to accompany all entries to the KACA exhibitions.

All applicants may submit **up to 6 works** for the **Material Mastery Exhibition** and the **KACA Members exhibition** (efforts will be made to be as inclusive as possible for the members exhibition). Both exhibitions will be selected from the digital images submitted. Each participant is asked to submit up to 6 images of their work by August 15, 2010.

All mediums are acceptable and the entries must be original artwork completed within the last four years and not displayed in past KACA exhibitions or in the Strecker-Nelson Gallery.

Artists are responsible for the insurance of their work while in transit and on display at the Strecker-Nelson Gallery and Chapman Gallery. Every effort will be made to carefully handle and re-pack the work, but the Strecker-Nelson Gallery and Chapman Gallery will not have an insurance rider for the exhibition.

ENTRY MATERIALS

To enter the exhibition, please send Dylan Beck:

1. Completed **entry form** and the digital images of the artwork on a CD.
2. Completed **membership form** and payment of 2010-11 membership dues.

Works for the exhibition will be selected from the submitted digital images. The images need to be JPEG or Tiff formatted files with 300 pixels per inch resolution and a width and/or height maximum of 1800 pixels (6 inches). The CD should only contain the images being entered.

***Digital files should be named using the following format:

(LastName)_(FirstName).jpg (.tif)

Example: smith_john.jpg (.tif)

Three-dimensional works may be represented by two images (label *a* and *b*) from different views. CDs will not be returned.

Entry materials must be received by **August 15, 2010**

Material Mastery: KACA National Juried Exhibition – Glen R. Brown and Dylan J. Beck

Glen R. Brown is a critic and full professor of art history at Kansas State University. An elected member of the International Academy of Ceramics in Geneva, Switzerland, he has written extensively about contemporary and historical ceramics.

Dylan J. Beck is a ceramic and multimedia artist and assistant professor of Ceramics at Kansas State University. Beck's artwork explores built space and the idea that manmade landscapes express a society's material and political priorities.

KACA 2010 Members Exhibition – Hoss Haley

Hoss Haley creates two- and three-dimensional works in steel, concrete, and bronze. He favors industrial materials and fabrication methods, often building or adapting the machines and tools he uses to produce his work. Hoss learned machining and steel fabrication at an early age and then apprenticed as a blacksmith for several years in Texas and New Mexico. Decades later his work is heavily influenced both conceptually and aesthetically by the western landscape of his youth.

Following this, work may be picked up during normal Gallery hours (Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m.) from Nov 15 – 31. If not picked up by Dec 1st, Chapman Gallery will dispose of the work.
