

## REGISTRATION

For the basic registration price, you can attend and participate in the Friday Night Iron Pour, Holly Hanessian lecture and the exhibition receptions, as well as the Saturday KACA welcome and business meetings, Holly Hanessian hands-on ceramics workshop, her keynote speech on "Material Mastery: The Question of Skill" and the KACA Silent Art Auction. To reserve a spot and participate in the other workshops you will need to pay a materials fee for the tools and supplies, many of the workshops will provide you with a Take Home Kit, so the creativity doesn't stop here. As space is limited in each studio, preference will be given to those wanting to participate in the hands-on activity on a first come, first serve basis. If space remains open, those wanting to observe, but not participate, can fill the open seats.

Our deadline for ordering meals is October 13, if you do not pre-register, we are sorry, but we cannot sell meal tickets at the door. If you did not pre-register, please plan to eat in the community for breakfast and lunch on Saturday. The reception on Friday night is a potluck, please bring a great "snacky" dish to share with friends. FHSU will provide non-alcoholic drinks during the reception.
